The information gained from this assessment will be valuable in helping the Session as we make decisions about the future of UPC.

In mid-April, you will receive an email with a unique link to the CAT. Click on the link and tell us about your experiences in and priorities for our church. Please do not discuss the survey or your answers with others as this may influence their answers. Paper copies will be available at the church office with a self-addressed stamped return envelope.

All answers are strictly anonymous. We have no way of matching any assessment to a particular person, so please feel free to candidly share your perceptions, opinions and experiences. Our planning for our future together is dependent on your participation and honest answers.

FAMILY PROMISE


FP Giving Day: Thursday, April 11th
