STAR WORDS

The use of Star Words, also called "star gifts," is a prayer practice connected to Epiphany and the new year that has been growing in popularity. The idea is that a list of intention words, or guiding words, are written or printed on paper stars. These paper stars are then arranged on the Communion Table or in a large basket. On Sunday, January 5, at our Epiphany service, you will be invited to draw a word from the basket, and to use that word as a guiding word throughout the year. Place your star word somewhere that you will see it regularly throughout the year – the refrigerator door, the bathroom mirror, next to your computer, or the dashboard of your car - to allow consistent reflection on how God has moved through, around, or in connection to that word. If you are not at the Epiphany service, Star Words will be available in the overflow room for the month of January.

Here are some questions to help you reflect on your word:

What are your initial thoughts about the word?

What is the definition of your word?

What are the different forms your word can take? How do the different forms change its meaning?

What synonyms of your word come to mind? How do they help to shape your understanding of your word?

What scripture passages or stories does your word bring to mind? If you need some help, try going to biblegateway.com or use a Bible concordance to look up passages.

How might this word guide you in the coming year?

I look forward to hearing how your Star Word leads you to be present to God's presence this year.

LAY PASTOR PROGRAM - EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITY

The Synod of the Rocky Mountains (and all the Presbyteries) have partnered with Dubuque Theological Seminary to offer training for those who are interested in becoming a Commissioned Lay Pastor or just taking one of the classes to help support the ministry of your congregation or the larger Presbytery. The preaching class has already taken place. However, the next scheduled class to come is:
